

A brief CV of Professor Chen-Hsen Lee

Prof. Lee was born and educated in Taiwan. He received his MD degree from National Taiwan University in 1971; and completed his surgical training in the University Hospital as well as the Taipei Veterans General Hospital, and working as a general surgeon. In 1978, he started his career of Endocrine Surgeons as a research associate (instructor) with Dr. Edwin L. Kaplan, in the University of Chicago. Soon after, he was approved as member of the International Association of Endocrine Surgeons (IAES) in 1981

In 1988, he was one of the founding member of the Asian Association of Endocrine Surgeons together with President Fujimoto ;and helped to host the 3rd in 1992, as well as the president the 9th AsAES in 2004. He established the connection of Taiwan with major centers of endocrine surgery in the world and helped to educate many active surgeons in medical centers throughout the country. Many of them are now council members of the Taiwan Association of Endocrine Surgeons.

In 2011, he was elected as President-elect; and serve as President of IAES from 2013 to 2015.

He is now working part time and serving as consultant professor in Taipei VGH and National Yang-Ming University where he had served as Deputy Director for 7 years, and Dean of Medical School for 6 years, respectively. In 2017, he was appointed as Professor of Lectures at Chiao-tung University, Hsinchu, Taiwan and join the development of Bio-ICT industry.
