

## **Barbra (Barb) Miller**

Dr. Barbra (Barb) Miller is Professor of Surgery in the Division of Surgical Oncology at The Ohio State University Wexner Medical Center and James Cancer Hospital and Solove Research Institute, Co-Director of the Comprehensive Adrenal Program, and Division Director of Clinical Operations. Dr. Miller completed medical school at University of Cincinnati followed by general surgery residency at University of Texas – Southwestern. She pursued fellowship training in endocrine surgery at University of Michigan, and then returned to Texas (UTHSC-San Antonio) briefly before joining the faculty at University of Michigan. She spent nearly 15 years contributing to the development of Michigan's internationally recognized endocrine oncology program and developing specific expertise in adrenal disorders. In 2020, she was recruited to The Ohio State University to develop the health system's new adrenal program. Her research interests include clinical outcomes, analytical morphomics, ultrasound, intraoperative PTH monitoring, adrenal disorders and optimization of care.

Dr. Miller serves as the Secretary of the American Association of Endocrine Surgeons (2022-2025). She was a Co-Chair of the forthcoming Adrenal Cancer section for the American College of Surgeons Operative Standards in Cancer Surgery, is the lead for the ACS Adrenal Cancer synoptic operative report project, serves on the Executive Committee of the ACS National Ultrasound Faculty and Co-Chairs the annual ACS thyroid/parathyroid/neck ultrasound course.
